

## Flowers in Good Shepherd Church:

January 2011

Flowers may be placed in the Church urns which remain in place on the Reredos. They should not be taller than the candles and should allow a priest to stand and walk behind the altar. The flowers will remain in place for the Sunday following the wedding to honor the bride and groom.

Flowers may be placed in the large urns by the stairs; they will hold large arrangements or plants. These should also be left in place unless someone in the wedding party wants to remove them after the wedding.

Candle holders may be requested for evening weddings, for a set up and take down fee of \$150.00. They may be enhanced with simple arrangements or ribbons. The pews may be festooned with arrangements as long as they are not attached to any wood surface and are not damp. Please limit these pew arrangements as they will have to be removed after the service by the church staff.

There are urns in the narthex, at the aisle entrance, and they may hold arrangements or plants. These should also be left in place unless someone in the wedding party wants to remove them after the wedding. Also in the narthex are two large tables. Arrangements may be placed on these.

Runners are not allowed.

Petals or other materials may not be placed on the floors as decorations (flower girls are allowed to drop petals while processing).

The use of artificial plant or flower material is not allowed.
